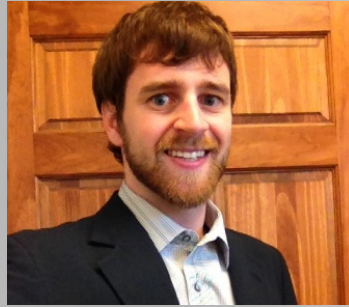

Steven Milcinovic

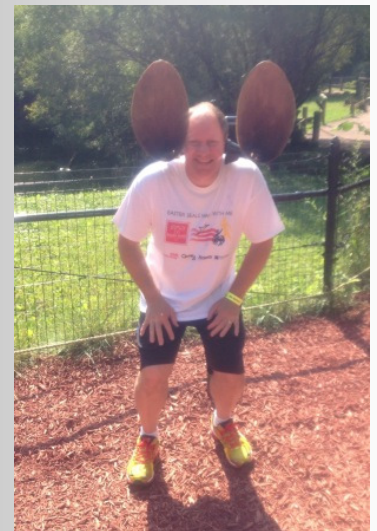
